(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow various cabling works to be carried out in preparation for the installation of high speed broadband, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Downs Road, East Studdal and Church Hill, Sutton, in the Dover area.

Phased closures are planned from Monday 30 July 2018, for up to 2 weeks.

Downns Road / Church Hill will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Northbourne Road (East Studdal), to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site, with no through access.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Downs Road, Homestead Lane, Roman Road, Abby Top, Vicarage Farm Road and Forge Lane back to Church Hill.

At certain times, Northbourne Road will be closed at the junction with Downs Road / Church Hill and can be accessed from Stoneheap Bottom Road

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.
